

Residence Permit Purpose of Study (9.13)

Stipendium Hungaricum 2025/2026

1	Dully filled and signed application form for residence permit and Appendix 9.13 ; one of the parents also have to sign the application (minor)
2	Two recent passport size photographs in color with white background (3.5 cm by 4.5 cm) not older than 3 months
3	Valid passport with the previous (old) passports (at least 2 blank pages in the valid passport are needed and the passport has to be issued within the previous 10 years). Passport must be valid until at least 3 months after the intended stay.
4	Flight ticket reservation
5	Valid insurance at least for 30 days (for all Schengen countries, for all risks e.g. accident, illness, medical emergency, evacuate of arrival and departure)
6	Confirmed accommodation (for the whole period of stay, at least more than 90 days) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • private accommodation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ filled Notification of accommodation ○ rental contract, accommodation by courtesy, title deed... ecc. • dormitory, hotel: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Notification of accommodation NO NEED ○ confirmation of accommodation in a dormitory ○ hotel reservation
7	Letter of Award from Stipendium Hungaricum Association (Tempus Közalapítvány - TKA)
8	Letter of admission from the university
9	School certificates in English, the most recent school certificates (high school graduation, university degree...ecc.)
10	CV and signed Motivation letter in English
11	Language exam certificate , if applicable
12	Certified translation of birth certificate (Shenasnameh) of the applicant and the legal representative.
13	Letter of consent for the minor's stay in Hungary, signed by the parent(s) or legal guardian, with an English translation.

Family members of any third-country national holding or applying for a residence permit for the purpose of studies cannot apply for a residence permit on the basis of family reunification.

NOTE: If the documents you are submitting are in a language other than English, **you need to have them translated in English**. All the translation should be stamped by Iran's Judiciary and Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The translation of the birth

certificate/marriage certificate must be no more than 6 months old. Translation of other documents must not be older than 1 year.

Issuing the visa is subject to the submission of the documents listed. The Embassy reserves the right to request further documentation.

Original documents must be presented during the personal interview with the visa officer and **a copy also must be submitted.**
