

<b>Residency for digital nomads - White Card (9.18) - 2025</b>	
1	Dully filled and signed <b>application form</b> for residence permit and <b>Appendix 9.18</b>
2	Two recent passport size <b>photographs</b> in color with white background (3.5 cm by 4.5 cm ) not older than 3 months
3	Valid <b>passport</b> with the previous (old) passports (at least 2 blank pages in the valid passport are needed and the passport has to be issued within the previous 10 years). Passport must be valid until at least 3 months after the intended stay.
4	<b>Flight ticket reservation</b>
5	Valid <b>insurance</b> or equivalent financial coverage for the full range of health care benefits ( <b>if</b> general insurance is provided by the Employer, short term travel insurance is sufficient for the application)
6	Confirmed <b>accommodation</b> (for long term period) – for ex.: lease agreement, accommodation by courtesy, title deed, ... etc.
7	Certified translation of birth certificate ( <b>Shenasnameh</b> ) of the applicant
8	<b>Proof of employment</b> (employment contract, certificate of shareholding in a company...etc.) <i>Details: OIF website / Residence in Hungary / White Card</i>
9	Valid preliminary “ <b>Workforce Needs Registration Form</b> ” issued by competent Hungarian authority.
10	<b>Certificate of higher education</b> (diploma, degree.. etc.) (not mandatory, but recommended)
11	<b>CV</b> in English (not mandatory, but recommended)
12	<b>Proof of income:</b> employment certificate, salary slip, proof of bank transactions, etc.
13	Title deed, if applicable
14	<b>Bank account certificate</b> with current balance and the <b>last 3 months bank statement</b> , counting from the date of your interview
15	110 Euro as <b>Visa Fee</b>

**Family members of any third-country national holding or applying for a residence permit for the purpose of “White Card” cannot apply for a residence permit on the basis of family reunification.**

NOTE: If the documents you are submitting are in a language other than English, **you need to have them translated in English**. All the translation should be stamped by Iran’s Judiciary and Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Translations must be no more than 1 year old.

**Issuing the visa is subject to the submission of the documents listed.** The Embassy reserves the right to request further documentation.

Original documents must be presented during the personal interview with the visa officer and **a copy also must be submitted.**
